① What kind of Russia is? (In reply to women sisters)

Russia is the biggest country in the world. It is 80 times bigger than our country. Its population is 20 times larger than our population.

1. 20 years ago the Russian people also had to do forced labor, to pay taxes, were oppressed and exploited, were <sup>as</sup> miserable and ignorant as our people now.

- Peasants have a lot of land to plough. The state lend them tractors and harvestors. A tractor can plough 1,000 ha a day. Each person has 5 kg of rice a day. So the people have more than enough rice and clothes.

- Women: many of them have become high ranking officials, physicians, pilots etc. They enjoy all rights as men do.

- The Youth: boy or girl must go to school from 8 to 16. They can have higher education if they want. They go to school free of charge, and the government even gives some subsidies.

- Children, the old people are taken care by the government. people who fall ill are treated by physicians provided by the state.

The people have the right to select from villages notables to the head of state who can also be impeached by the people if they are not good. Citizens who are 18 years old have the right to select and to be selected by the people to become leaders. So no one is oppressed, unlike our country.

In sum: the Russian people are very happy now. We should bear in our mind that: they have such happiness because they have had to struggle for so many years. If we want to have that happiness, we must be united to struggle.
