① Things that Cadres Should Know (II)

1. Cadres should try their best to work for organizations; they should place common interests above personal interests. Organizations should be given priority. Things beneficial to organizations should be done and vice versa. Any one who places personal work above common work does not deserve to be a cadre.

2. Cadres must comply with discipline strictly; organizations, like the army, can only work effectively with strict disciplines. Cadres from high to low levels must strictly comply with disciplines setting examples for members to follow. They should accomplish the work assigned to them and faithfully report to the higher-level cadres. If they are sent to one place, they must not move to others on their will.

3. Cadres must try their best to keep secret and instruct members to keep secret. We must not let the enemy know anything at all about our work. Coming from other localities, cadres should dress and go about similarly to the local inhabitants. When going to a locality or staying in certain houses, they must not reveal that locality or house. Local cadres should not gather at one place. Always remind members and children to keep secret.

4. When there is news of terror, cadres must keep calm, not be astonished. The news should be given thorough assessment and inspection, because there is often misinformation. Then precautions should be taken, but work should be done without intervals.

5. Cadres should set examples for members to follow: If the cadres are right, members will follow them. If cadres respect organizations, comply with disciplines and keep secret and calm, members will gradually train themselves in such manner. We should know that: if cadres make mistakes or wrongdoings, not only the work is unfinished, but the cadres also follow the bad example and make further mistakes. So from the heads of groups to high-level cadres must try their best to work and

train their personal capacity
