SHORT-COMINGS OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEES FOR NATIONAL SALVATION.

This is the biggest shortcoming of these committees. We have set up separate organizations, different walks of life such as associations for national salvation such as the youth association for national salvation, the peasant association for national salvation, the women association for national salvation, the pioneer association for national salvation, since each strata of people has special tasks different tasks.
