### Opposing Terrorism

#### Imperialists' scheme of defeating our revolutionary cause:

At the end of last year, imperialists sent the old Fox Tuan Bach (a province-head) to Cao Bang for enticing revolution men to give up their cause and give themselves to the imperialists. The Revolution men must know that when the imperialists are on the verge of their death, they leave no efforts to attack the Revolutionary cause

## Appraisal

Imperialists have recently terrorized a locality. Thanks to the wisdom of the locality cadres and our association's members, the imperialists caught nothing. After the imperialists' withdrawal, the cadres met and exchanged experiences and discussed ways to reassure old people who were a bit worried.

Therefore, the Revolution men must try their best for not being trapped by the imperialists. So we must do these things:

1 We must keep secret: Several members of our association, for the imperialists' weakness, disregard them, thus not trying their best to keep secret. It is a very big mistake. From now on we must keep secret more, as much as possible. If we want to keep secret we must:

a, carefully consider, consider for long when we admit a new member. Then we report the case to the local committee to revise it. If there's nothing suspicious, we can admit him or her.

b, For admitted members, pay attention to everyone, especially to anyone who is suspected of his speaking, who is curious about the association's work, who has relations with secret police and their henchmen.

c, not keep our documents at home. Whenever we take them home to study, we must be very careful.

d, As far as the association's work (just like meetings, self-depending practice) is concerned, we must keep it in secret. The places of meeting and gathering must be often changed. Only anyone who has got the duty to know and is a very liable can know about these places.

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e, choose our heralds as very reliable ones. And the heralds' work must be more secret than before.  
 f, Anyone working in secret must be quite secret now.

2, We must know to self-depend  
 As the imperialists attack our revolutionary cause, we have no reason not to prevent them, to fight against them. The prevention and opposition of terrorism is the self-depending forces' duty. For the self-depending, we must do three things: a, We must inspect news from the secret police and imperialists, especially we must closely watch strangers who arrive in our villages

b, We must guard our locality, pay attention to the paths leading into our village, and guard places when we have meetings.

c, In case of important or urgent news, we must immediately inform surrounding localities of the news, so they can put themselves on the alert. We must carefully arrange these three things if we have the self-depending forces.

3, What should we react if we are terrorized? If we do these three things, we will never be terrorized. As our members fail to implement them, the imperialists can terrorize us. If the imperialists terrorize us, we must keep calm, not worry and wisely cope with them, not make them suspicious of anything. The self-depending forces must at once inform at the places necessary places to beware of the imperialists after the imperialists' withdrawal, cadres must meet and exchange experiences and later send memos to reassure anyone who is a bit worried.

Conclusion

Our most urgent work now is to opposing terrorism. The Imperialists, the nearer on the verge of their death, the more fiercedly terrorize us. If we know how to cope with it we will win and the imperialists will be defeated.
