① The Anti-Terror Vanguard Commissions must be formed.

In order to fight terror, the anti-terror vanguard commissions must be organized.

A. How to organize the anti-terror commissions? The V. M. Communal committees select 5, 7 or 9 members who are enthusiastic, courageous, quick-minded to form an anti-terror vanguard commission which a head and deputy head are to be appointed to take charge of the commission's work.

B. What is the work of the anti-terror vanguard commissions?

1. To explain and convince all members not to be afraid of terror. After getting the exact news of the terror, the commission must send its people to explain at once. The imperialists' measures to sabotage the revolution, say, to dispatch spies to villages, or misinformations provided by the imperialists to threaten the revolution, say, Japan and France are very powerful and the revolutionaries will be executed must also be explained immediately.

2. Normally, precaution taken of the terror should be explained. In order to take precaution, the commission must:

- dispatch its people to investigate carefully;
- examine the suspected members;
- keep secret. Documents should not be left at home and should not be carried in great amount on the way;
- detect the reactionaries, spies and surround them.

Inform the news of the terror to the surrounding villages.

3. To explain the ways to deal with terror

- keep calm, not to be dismayed;
- Hearing the imperialists are coming, examine whether there are documents at home and inform the news to other places;
- when asked by the imperialists, clever answers should be given, disclosure of oneself and the locality be avoided;
- If arrested and tortured by the imperialists, be resolute.

4. After the terror, carry out investigations ^{of} how is the terror and explain and convince the people and members not to fear. If it is possible, meetings should be held.
