- 1) We do not have to work as coolies, to pay heavy and unreasonable taxes.
- 2) Properties of the imperialists and reactionaries are confiscated and distributed to the people or kept as public properties.
- 3) The people have freedom to speak, to travel within our country or abroad, to do anything they want.
- 4) The people will master the country, will not be exploited, oppressed and have full rights to do things of their interest.
- 5) Our country is already rich, but our people will try to work more to make it richer. At that time peasants can have enough land to cultivate, workers have enough jobs. All people are employed and happy. In the rural as well as urban areas there will be schools, theatres, cinemas, electric lights, automobiles. Patients will have hospitals. Children will play in their own gardens. The old will rest in the old's institutions. The Mau brothers can have for their meals the rice from Saigon and fish sauce from Quang Yen. During break time the people go to "clubs" to read newspapers, play music or listen on the radios to Hanoi's reformed music. After working for 11 months, the people will have 1 month off for holidays during they can travel, even abroad.
- 6) Women will be equal to men, will have the rights to schooling, to becoming high-ranking government officials, to mastering their families and country.
- 7) In our Indochina, all nationalities - Tho', Mau, Ming, Kinh consider each other brothers of a common family. Who emulate with each other to make our

Country stronger, richer.

8) At that time, when we go abroad, we will solemnly claim ourselves Vietnamese citizens.

If we want to have such happiness, what should we do, brothers and sisters?
