- Red Army ~~sets~~ reaches German border and marches into Poland's Capital

- Japan Cabinet collapses

1 - The Red Army has reached ~~the~~ German border and cut off the retreating roads of all ~~the~~ ^{German troops} contingents in the North. On the ~~Middene~~ Middle Front, the Red Army has marched into Warsaw ~~and Poland's~~ ~~Cap~~ - the Capital city of Poland and taken ~~the~~ control three-fourths of Poland. So, within a month, the Red Army has gone ~~to 7 hundred~~ 600 to 700 kilometres forward and German troops run like ducks.

2 Germany ^{is suffering} ~~is~~ ~~is~~ heavily defeated. The people hated Hitler. By an order of a general a bomb has been thrown into Hitler's Cabin. Many high rank officers died. Hitler escaped death by chance. At present indiscriminate arrests and killing is carried out. Many German generals on the Front with the Russians have been arrested and shot death.
